

Know all men by these presents: That I S. A. Wood of  
 the City of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consider-  
 ation of the sum of Seven hundred dollars, to me in  
 hand paid by Jane A. Archibald of Lawrence No. 3. The  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold  
 and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and  
 quit-claim unto the said Jane A. Archibald and to her heirs  
 and assigns for, all my right, title, estate, interest, claim and  
 demand, in possession or expectancy of, in and to the following  
 described land, situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid,  
 to wit, Lot number Seventy-four (74) Ohio Street and  
 house to have and to hold the above described premises,  
 with the privilege and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto  
 the said Jane A. Archibald heirs and assigns forever.

And I the said Samuel A. Wood for my self and  
 my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant  
 with the said Jane A. Archibald, her heirs and  
 assigns, that the said premises are free from all encum-  
 brances made or suffered by me that I have full right  
 and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same,  
 and that I shall and will warrant and defend the  
 same unto the said Jane A. Archibald her heir  
 and assigns for ever against the lawful claims and demands  
 of all persons claiming through or under me but against none  
 other. And I the said Samuel A. Wood my heirs  
 executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound  
 by these presents in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars  
 to the said Jane A. Archibald her heirs and assigns  
 to make and convey unto her or them all further right  
 or title which shall or may be awarded or convey to me  
 by any authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue  
 of a title to the townsite of Lawrence aforesaid issu-  
 ing from the general land office.
