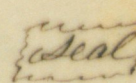


This Indenture, made the 20th day of December A.D. 1858. between S. N. Wood of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas the one part, and S. E. Parker of Reading County of Mass. in the State of Massachusetts of the other part. Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and twenty dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part before the sealing and delivery of these presents, have granted released and quit claimed, and by these presents do grant release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the City of Lawrence County of Douglas & Territory of Kansas to wit. Lot Number one (1) on Pinckney Street - also Lots eighty six (86) and one hundred and six, (106) on Ohio Street, also Lot No one hundred and sixty one (161) on Tennessee Street - all in said Lawrence as known and designated on the published plats of said City.

To have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances, unto the said S. E. Parker his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
