

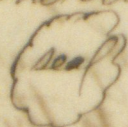

Crane, his heirs and assigns, all my right title, claim and demand in and unto Lots No^s (22, 24, 26) twenty two, twenty four, twenty six, Kentucky Street with the buildings thereon situated in the Town of Lawrence Kansas Territory To have and to hold the same to the said John L. Crane his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant to warrant and defend said granted, and quit claimed premises to the said John L. Crane his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by or under me.

In Witness Whereof, I the said Henry Belcher have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight
