

This Indenture made this 20th day of August A.D. 1859 between Hugh Cameron of Douglas County Kansas Territory of the first part & James F. Cameron of Jefferson County Kansas Territory of the second part Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of (260) two hundred and sixty dollars in hand paid by said James F. Cameron of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has conveyed, released and quit-claimed and by these presents does convey, release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs administrators and assigns all right title interest in and to certain lots of land situate and being in the City of Lawrence Douglas County K. T. & described on Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl October A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit, lots Louisiana Street (34) Thirty four, Pennsylvania Street (65) Sixty five, Delaware Street (93) ninety three, Ohio Street (207) Two hundred and seven, Indiana Street (193) one hundred and ninety three and Mississippi Street (327) three hundred and twenty seven and (329) three hundred and twenty nine, to have and to hold the aforesaid described lots with all the privileges & appurtenances thereunto belongs unto the said party of the second part, and the said party of the first part hereby agrees to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right title or interest in or to the aforesaid town lots whatsoever.
