 G. F. Simpson of the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas  
 party of the first part, and James Doyle of the County of Douglas  
 and Territory party of the second part. Witnesseth that the  
 said party of the first part, for and in consideration of Sixty  
 Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has  
 and by these presents doth grant, Sell and Convey unto  
 the said party of the second part, and his heirs and  
 assigns forever, the following described tract <sup>to</sup> or part  
 of Land in the town of Lawrence, being and lying in  
 the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas, to wit,  
 Lot number one hundred and seventy six (176)  
 on Illinois Street. To have and to hold the  
 same unto the said party of the second part, his heirs  
 and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part  
 hereby covenants that he is lawfully seized in fee of the  
 premises aforesaid; that they are free and clear from all  
 incumbrances whatever, and that he the said party of  
 the first part his heirs and assigns, shall and will forever  
 warrant and defend the same to the said party  
 of the second part, his heirs and assigns against the law  
 ful claims of all persons whomsoever.
