 ing to the Survey made by A. D. Searle A. D. 1854.

 And I Francis Hoillam aforesaid my heirs, executors, administra-
 tors and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in
 the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to said H. F. Parker
 aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
 to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the
 said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or
 persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described
 property, to have and to hold the same, with all the
 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
