Know all men by these presents, That whereas Shalar W. Eldridge, Thomas B. Eldridge and Edwin S. Eldridge are copartners together as Eldridge Brothers, and by their partnership name and style of Eldridge Brothers on the fifth day of October A.D. Eighteen hundred & fifty seven (1857) did make execute and deliver to Charles B. Pellett a certain indenture of mortgage, wherein and whereby they granted, sold and conveyed unto the said Pellett amongst certain other lots or parcels of land situated in the city of Lawrence, County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas, and which are particularly set forth and described in said indenture of Mortgage - lots numbered Eighty Eight (88) and Ninety one (91) on Rhode Island Street in said city, County and State aforesaid, to have and to hold upon the conditions expressed in said indenture of mortgage which said indenture of mortgage was duly executed in the Registers Office at Lawrence Kansas, in Book F, at pages 117 and 118.

And whereas the said Charles B. Pellett, on the twenty fifth day of September A.D. eighteen hundred and fifty nine (1859) for a valuable consideration to him paid by Robert Morrow of said city of Lawrence did sell, assign and transfer by deed of assignment duly executed by him the said Pellett, to the said Robert Morrow, the said indenture of mortgage and all and singular all
