November 13, 1858 \$100. December 24, 1858 \$871⁰⁰/₁₀₀. January 21, 1859 \$10. and January 26, 1859 \$100. and February 15, 1859 \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀ making in all Seventeen hundred and twenty one ³⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars for his use and benefit hereby authorizing him to collect and enforce payment thereof in my name or otherwise, but at his own costs or charges, and I do hereby covenant that the said note and Mortgage now belongs to me and that I have good right to sell and assign the same, Witness my hand and seal this 25th day of September A. D. 1859.
