

Know all men by these presents; That I
 William Bishop of Lawrence Douglas County Territory
 of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of One
 Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid,
 by Emma B. Bishop of the same place the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-
 claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim
 unto the said Emma B. Bishop and to her heirs and
 assigns forever, all my right, title, estate, interest claim and
 demand in possession and expectancy of, in and to the follow-
 ing described land, situated in the city of Lawrence a-
 foreaid to wit The eastern half of Lot number six (6)
 on Pinkney Street To have and to hold the above
 described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances
 thereto belonging, unto the said Emma B. Bishop her
 heirs and assigns forever. And I the said William
 Bishop for myself and my heirs, executors and adminis-
 trators do covenant with the said Emma B. Bishop her heirs
 and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbran-
 ces made or suffered by me, that I have full right and
 power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that I
 shall and will warrant and defend the same unto
 the said Emma B. Bishop her heirs and assigns forever,
 against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
 claiming by, through or under me but against none other.
 And I the said William Bishop my heirs, executors
 and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these
 presents in the sum of Three hundred dollars, to the said
 Emma B. Bishop her heirs and assigns, to make and convey
 unto her or them all further right or title which shall
 or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority
 or by any person or persons whom soever.
