of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to me in hand paid by Hen-  
ry Brown of the City of Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these  
presents do bargain sell and quit claim, unto the said Henry Brown  
and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right, title, estate, claim  
interest and demand, in possession or expectancy of, in and to the  
following described land, situated in the City of Lawrence  
aforesaid to wit Lot number thirteen (13) on the Park near  
Massachusetts St. To have and to hold the above described prem-  
ises, with the privileges and appurtenances and appurtenances thereto  
belonging, unto the said Henry Brown his heirs and assigns forever.  
And I the said Tho<sup>s</sup> Guest for myself and my heirs, executors  
and administrators, do covenant with the said Henry Brown  
his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encum-  
brances made or suffered by me, that I have full right and  
power to sell, convey and quit claim the same, and that I  
shall and will warrant and defend the same unto  
the said Henry Brown his heirs and assigns. And I the  
said Tho<sup>s</sup> Guest, my heirs, executors and administrators  
are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum  
of three hundred dollars, to the said Henry Brown his  
heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them  
all further right or title which shall or will may be awarded or  
conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons  
whomsoever. — In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
