This Indenture Made this Fifth day of October A.D. 1859. between Frederick Kimball and Martha A. Kimball, Samuel Kimball and Adeline Kimball, Franklin Kimball and Elizabeth Kimball and Edward Kimball of Lawrence, Kansas Territory of the first part, and Jesse C. Connor of East Pittsfield, Maine, of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant, bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever all our interest in the following described land, situated in Douglas County, Kansas Territory, to wit Reserve number two (2) in Lawrence according to the survey made by and plat as made by A. T. Deard (and mortgaged to Franklin, Frederick, Samuel, and Edward Kimball to Nathan Stark on the first day of March 1858.) together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining both in law and equity. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage, to secure the payment of the sum of Four Hundred dollars six months after this date with interest at the rate of three per cent per month according to the conditions of a certain Note this day executed and delivered by the said Frederick, Samuel, Franklin and Edward Kimball to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment
