Wood of the County and Territory aforesaid all of my right title and claim in and to the North half of lot number forty (40) on Massachusetts Street in said Town of Lawrence for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars the same to be credited on the bond or article of agreement that said Wood held against me for a Town Interest that I purchased of him according to said agreement said lot number forty (40) being one lot in said interest the North half of which said lot I have relinquished and resold back to said Wood for the above consideration.
