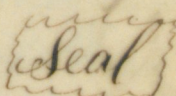

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten hundred and thirty two dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all the following described land, situated in Lawrence Douglas County Kansas Territory, to wit. The North half of Lot Seventeen Massachusetts Street together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, both in law and equity.
