giving and granting to the said G. Groenew full power
and authority to foreclose said Mortgage as to said lot No 94.

so to do shall be necessary. And I do hereby release all claim of
interest, title, right or equity in and to said lot by virtue of said
Mortgage, to the said G. Groenew and I do also agree
