

to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I
Shall and will Warrant and Defend the same unto
the said John L. Crane his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
claiming by, through or under me but against none other.

And I the said S. S. Hicks my heirs executors and
administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents
in the sum of Three hundred & Twenty dollarz, to the said
John L. Crane his heirs and assigns to make and convey
unto him or them all further right or title which shall or
may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority
or by any person or persons whomsoever the said S. S.
Hicks and Charlotte E. Hicks wife of the said
S. S. Hicks hereby relinquishes all her right of dower
in said lot.
