 administrators shall well and truly make to Lyman Allen  
 his heirs executors administrators or assigns a good and sufficient  
 deed to the following parcels of land lying in the City of Law-  
 rence viz 76. Park St. 214. 6th St. 161, 163 Low St. 135. N. 4th and to  
 ten acres of land of an average value of the quarter section  
 occupied by A. H. Mallory in said City of Lawrence on  
 the payment of the following promissory notes dated March
