Saxon of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Oldham and Saxon and to their heirs and assigns forever, all my right, title, estate, interest, claim and demand, in possession or expectancy of, in and to the following described land situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid town, lot number Sixty one (61) on New Jersey Street To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said Oldham and Saxon their heirs and assigns forever.

And I the said William N. Baldwin for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Oldham & Saxon their heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall warrant and defend the same unto the said Oldham and Saxon their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me but against none other.

And I the said William N. Baldwin my heirs, executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, to the said Oldham and Saxon their heirs and assigns to make and convey unto them all further right or title which I shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons whom I sever.
