How all men by these presents; That I Ferdinand Fuller of the town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by George Churchill of Lawrence aforesaid being the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Churchill his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land Situated and lying in the town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according to the Survey made by A. D. 1857. To wit Lot number one hundred and fifty nine (169) on Indiana Street, and to Ferdinand Fuller aforesaid, my heirs executors administrators and assigns am held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Two hundred dollars to the said Churchill aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from and power, or person or persons whomsoever may and all of the other described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
