bargain sell and quit claim, unto the said Magdalena Haag  
her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever all our  
right, title, claim, interest, and demand, in and to the following  
described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in  
the Territory of Kansas, to wit: Lot numbered Twenty eight on Ohio  
Street And we the said William A. Baldwin, Mary Ann Baldwin  
and our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, do hold and  
firmly bind by these presents, in the sum of Two hundred dollars  
to the said Magdalena Haag her heirs, executors, administrators  
and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or  
them a good and valid title such as the said W. A. Baldwin  
or Mary Ann Baldwin shall receive from the Trustees of the  
City of Lawrence, to any and all of the above described prop-  
erty. To have and to hold the same with all the privilege and  
appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
