

Know all men by these presents; That we Martin F. Conway and Emily F. Conway his wife of the city of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of dollars to us in hand paid by Lemuel Fillmore of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Lemuel Fillmore and to his heirs and assigns forever all our right title estate interest claim and demand in possession or expectancy of in and to the following described land situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid to wit; Lot number Seventy (70) Ohio St To Have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Lemuel Fillmore his heirs and assigns forever.

And we the said Martin F. Conway and Emily F. Conway for ourselves and our heirs executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Lemuel Fillmore his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrance made or suffered by him; that we have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Lemuel Fillmore his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under us but against none other. And we the said Martin F. Conway and Emily F. Conway our heirs executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred dollars, to the said Lemuel Fillmore his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be annexed or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a till to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general land office.
