

Know all men by these presents. That I,
 A. Hancock of Douglas County, Territory of Kansas
 for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred
 Dollars, to him in hand paid by Benj W. Dyer of
 Randolph, Orange Co. Vermont the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit
 claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit
 claim unto the said Benj W. Dyer and to his heirs and
 assigns forever, all his right, title, estate, interest, claim and
 demands in possession of or expectancy of, in and to the follow
 ing described land, situated in the city of Lawrence
 Douglas County Kansas Territory, to wit Lot number
 one hundred eighteen (118) Rhode Island Street in the
 city of Lawrence according to a survey made by A.D. Seal, a plat
 of which is on file at the Land Office at Leavenworth.

To Have and To Hold, the above described premises
 with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
 unto the said Benj W. Dyer his heirs and assigns forever.
 And I the said H. A. Hancock for myself and my
 executors and administrators do covenant to the said
 said Benj W. Dyer his heirs and assigns that the said pre
 mises are free from all encumbrances, made or suffered by
 me, that I have full right and power to sell, convey and
 quitclaim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and
 defend the same unto the said Benj W. Dyer his heirs and
 assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all
 persons claiming by, through or under me, but against none
 other. And I the said H. A. Hancock my heirs, exec
 utors and administrators, are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of three Hundred dollars to the
 said Benj W. Dyer his heirs and assigns, to make and
 convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall
 or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority
 or by any person or persons whomsoever.
