This Indenture, Made this Fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty between Samuel Kimball and his wife Adaline A of Douglas County Territory of Kansas parties of the first part, and Edward Shaw of town of Portland State of Maine party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the Said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and forty four dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas, being the east one half of Lot No eighteen and twenty on Kentucky Street in said Lawrence according to the survey made by A. D. Seale A.D. 1854 said land being bounded as follows Beginning at a point fifty eight and one half feet east of the North west corner of said lot No eighteen thence running east fifty eight and one half feet to an alley, thence South one hundred feet to Winthrop Street thence West on said Street fifty eight and one half feet thence North to place of beginning one hundred feet containing five thousand eight hundred and fifty square feet together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining,
