by W. R. Judson of Lawrence the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and
quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain
sell and quit-claim unto the said W. R. Judson
his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever,
all my right, title, interest claim and demand
in and to the following described land, situate
and lying in the City of Lawrence, in the Ter-
ritory of Kansas, to wit, being lots seventy eight
and eighty (78 & 80) New York St. And I the said
D. H. Weir, my heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of Six Hundred dollars
to the said W. R. Judson his heirs, executors, admin-
istrators and assigns, to well and truly make
over and convey unto him or them a good
and valid title such as the said Grantor
shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Law-
rence, to any and all of the above described
property, to have and to hold the same, with
all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto
belonging, forever.
