

This Indenture, Made this twelfth day of March in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty
 between E. D. Ladd and Eliza J. his wife of the city
 of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas of the first part, and F. C.
 Pillsbury of the County of Sauk, State of Wisconsin of the
 Second part. Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first
 part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, to
 them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, there-
 cept whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and
 sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all those certain pieces
 or parcels of land situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid
 and described as follows, to wit Lots numbered Sixty five
 (65) and Sixty Seven (67) on Ohio Street together with
 all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging, or in any wise pertaining both in law
 and equity. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage
 to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred dollars
 and the interest on the same at two and one half per cent
 per month, in one year after the date hereof according
 to the condition of a certain promissory note this day executed
 and delivered by the said E. D. Ladd to the said party
 of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such
 payment be made as herein specified. But if default be
 made in payment or any part thereof as above provided,
 then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part,
 his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time here-
 after to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in
 the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the money
 arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for prin-
 cipal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making
 such sale and the attorney's fees for foreclosures, and the overplus,
 if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale,
 on demand, to the said E. D. Ladd and Eliza J. Ladd
 their heirs or assigns.
