To now all men by these presents. That I Augusta M. Eldridge
of Lawrence Douglas County Kansas Territory in considera-
tion of One thousand dollars paid by John Hutchinson of
Minneapolis of the State of Minnesota (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged) do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell
and quitclaim and convey to the said John Hutchinson
and heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land
situated in the town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas
and described as follows; to wit, on undivided half of lot
number twenty eight (28) on Massachusetts with all
the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, To have
and to hold the said premises to the said John Hutchinson
his heirs, and assigns, in fee simple, forever Provided
always, and these presents are upon this condition, that
if the said Augusta M. Eldridge her heirs, executors admin-
istrators, or assigns shall pay to said John Hutchinson his executors
administrators, or assigns the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200)
on the first day of May A.D. 1860 and the further sum
of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) on the first day of July
A.D. 1860 and the further sum of Seventy five dollars
(\$75.00) on the tenth day of September A.D. 1860 according
to the tenor and effect of three several promissory notes
this day given by the said Augusta M. Eldridge to the
said John Hutchinson then there present and the estate
hereby granted, shall cease and be void otherwise to remain
