Eldrige of Lawrence Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Augusta M. Eldrige her heirs, executors administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, Situate and lying in the town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A. D. Ward A. T. 1854. to wit, an undivided half of lot number twenty eight (28) Mass St. together with an undivided half of an office on the same now occupied by Dr. S. C. Fuller. And I Ruth E. Hutchinson aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to said Augusta M. Eldrige aforesaid her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto her or them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the said town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
