 right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the  
 same, and that I shall and will warrant and  
 defend the same unto the said George W.  
 Cosy, his heirs and assigns forever, against  
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons  
 claiming by, through or under me, but against  
 none other. And of the said Samuel S. Snyder,  
 my heirs, executors and administrators, are  
 held and firmly bound by these presents in  
 the sum of two hundred dollars, to the said  
 George W. Cosy his heirs and assigns, to make and  
 convey unto him or them all further right or title  
 which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to  
 me by any authority, or by any person or persons  
 by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence,  
 aforesaid issuing from the general land office.
