whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and  
sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said  
party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all that certain  
piece or parcel of land situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid  
and known as lot number Seventy five (75) on Connecticut  
Street to have and to hold the said premises with the appurte-  
nances, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns  
forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant  
with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that  
they are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid, that said  
premises are free and clear from all encumbrance, whatsoever  
and that they will forever warrant and defend the same  
with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part  
his heirs and assigns, against the lawful claim and of  
all persons whomsoever.
