 bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain  
 sell and quit claim unto the said Homer H. Moore and  
 to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title estate inter-  
 est, claim and demand, in possession or expectancy of  
 in and to the following described land, situated in Lawrence  
 Kansas Territory aforesaid, to wit, Lot number one hundred  
 and thirty five (135) on New York Street as surveyed  
 by A. D. Neal A. D. 1854. To have and to hold the above descri-  
 bed premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-  
 ing, unto the said Homer H. Moore his heirs and assigns forever  
 And I the said William Ritter for myself and my heirs  
 executors and administrators, do covenant with the said  
 Homer H. Moore his heirs and assigns, that the said premises  
 are free from all encumbrances, made or suffered by me  
 that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit-  
 claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and  
 defend the same unto the said Homer H. Moore  
 his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims  
 and demands of all persons claiming by through or under  
 me but against none other. And I the said William  
 Ritter my heirs, executors and administrators, are held and firmly  
 bound by these presents in the sum of three hundred dollars  
 to the said Homer H. Moore his heirs and assigns  
 to make and convey unto him or them all further  
 right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed  
 to me by any authority, or by any person or persons, by  
 virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid  
 issued from the general land office.
