And I, the said James S. Emery, my heirs, executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of five hundred dollars, to the said Rebecca Conforth her heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto her or them, all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the townsite of Lawrence of record, issuing from the General Land Office.
