May his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situated and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seal A. D. 1854. To wit. Lot number Eighty five (85) on Maryland Street And I Rebecca Cornforth aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of twenty dollars to said said Samuel C. May aforesaid his executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title to which I shall receive from the trustees of the said town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
