

Defend the same unto the said John Dought his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me, but against none other. And I the said A. J. Sheldon, my heirs, executors and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of three hundred dollars, to the said John Dought his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title, which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence, aforesaid, issuing from the general Land Office.

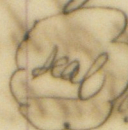
