This Indenture made this tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty between James Blood and Eliza J. Blood wife of the said James of Lawrence in the County of Douglas Territory of Kansas of the first part and George W. Colamore of the said Lawrence of the second part Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in Lawrence aforesaid being Lot Number fifteen (15) Block that is the lot situated at the corner of Massachusetts Street Quincy Street according to the plat of A. D. Searl filed in the Office of Register of Deeds of Douglas County April 5th 1860 and recorded in plat book No 1. page 8,
