This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Forty Eight Dollars, payable as follows. Thirteen Dollars to be paid in eight days from date, and Thirty five Dollars to be paid in sixty days from date according to the condition of two certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said Aaron Rotzenstein party of the first part to Robert Wilson of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in payment of any part thereof, as above provided then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of the money arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the attorneys fees for foreclosure and the surplus if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand to the said Aaron Rotzenstein his heirs or assigns.
