part, Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for and  
in Consideration of the sum of ~~thirty~~ dollars  
to him in hand paid by the said party of the second  
part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargained  
and bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant  
bargain and sell unto the said party of the second  
part his heirs and assigns, all the certain piece  
or parcel of land situated in Lawrence Doug-  
las County Kansas & described as follows lot No  
 Ninety nine (99) Connecticut St together with  
all and singular the hereditaments and ap-  
 pertenance thereto belonging, or in any wise  
pertaining both in law and equity. This Grant  
is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment  
of the sum of Thirty dollars with interest at the  
rate of twelve per cent per annum accord-  
ing to the conditions of a certain promissory  
note fully executed and delivered by the  
said Wiegand Yager to the said party of the second part,  
and this conveyance shall be void if such
