 on the Park and Lot number nine (9) on Finn
 Street To Have and to hold the above described premises
 with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing, unto the said Lathrop Bullene his heirs and
 assigns forever. And we the said Paul R. Brooks
 & Mary A. Brooks for ourselves and our heirs, ex-
 ecutors and administrators, do covenant with
 the said Lathrop Bullene his heirs and assigns
 that the said premises are free from all encum-
 brances made or suffered by us, that we
 have full right and power to sell, convey and
 quit claim the same, and that we shall and
 will warrant and defend the same unto
