

This Indenture, made this second day of June AD 1855, between Samuel L. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the County of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Ferdinand Fuller, party of the second part, witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, in hand paid by said Ferdinand Fuller, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents do convey, release and quitclaim, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart so surveyed by A. G. Smith, October AD 1854, as follows; to wit:-

Share number one hundred thirteen (113) containing lots as follows: Kentucky Street twenty nine (29)-Kentucky Street eighty nine (89) and one hundred twenty four (124)- Louisiana Street two hundred forty three (243)- Kentucky Street thirty eight (38)- New Jersey Street sixty eight (68)- Indiana Street two hundred thirty seven (237)- New Hampshire Street one hundred eighty two (182)- Delaware Street one hundred thirteen (113) and one hundred fifteen (115)- New Jersey Street one hundred fifty four (154) and Lot Kentucky Street one (1)-

To have and to hold the aforesaid quitclaimed premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand, in or to the aforesaid premises, or any part thereof: And we hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right, title or interest under the said Trustees, their heirs & successors.
