This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel Snyder Joel Grover John P. Wood William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory parties of the first part and Joel Grover party of the second part witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Joel Grover of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed released and quitclaimed and by these presents do convey, release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A.D. 1854 as follows. To-wit: number two hundred and nineteen (219) containing lots to-wit: Vermont Street fifty (50) Ohio Street forty eight (48) Tennessee Street one hundred (100) Connecticut Street sixty one (61) N. York Street forty seven (47) and Twenty two (22) Ohio Street one hundred and forty two (142) Tennessee Street sixty nine (69) and seventy one (71) and lot N. Hampshire Street fourteen (14)
