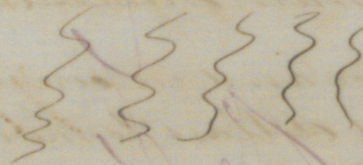
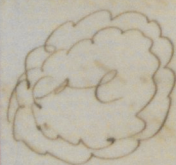

Searl, A.D. 1854, to wit: Lot number one hundred and forty-one (141) New Jersey Street. And I William Atwood aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of forty-dollars to said Turner Sampson aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and come unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence
