 Dipman, his wife of Douglas County Kansas Territory
 of the first part and Gordon Governor of Douglas Co-
 untly Kansas Territory of the second part witnesseth
 That the said parties of the first part for and in
 consideration of the sum of One Hundred and ten
 Dollars to them in hand paid the said party of the
 second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged have granted bargained and sold and by
 these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the
 said party of the second part his heirs and assign-
 es all that certain piece or parcel of land situated
 in the Town of Lawrence in Douglas County Kans-
 as Territory and described as follows Lot Number
 One Hundred and Twenty (120) New York street.
 together with all and singular the hereditaments and
 appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise ap-
 pertaining both in law and equity. This Grant is in-
 tended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum
 of One Hundred and Ten Dollars one year from the date
 hereof, with interest at the rate of Ten per cent per annum
 until paid, according to the condition of a certain prom-
 issory Note this day executed and delivered by the said John
 F. Dipman, to the said party of the second part; and this
 conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as here-
 in specified. But if default be made in payment or any
 part thereof as above provided, then it shall be lawful
 for the said party of the second part his executors, ad-
 ministrators and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the
 premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner

 such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal
 and interest together with the costs and charges of ma-
