

This Indenture Made this Fifteenth day of
 December in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and fifty between Caleb S. Pratt
 and John Pratt of Lawrence Kansas Territory of
 the first part and John W. Hutchinson of Minneapolis
 of the State of Minnesota of the second part witnesseth
 That the said party of the first part for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to
 us in hand paid by the said party of the sec-
 ond part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted, bargained and sold, and by
 these presents do grant grant, Bargain and sell
 unto the said party of the second part his heirs
 and assigns all that certain piece or parcel of
 land situated in Lawrence Kansas Territory
 The North half of Lot No (28) Twenty eight in Massachu-
 setts together with all and singular the heredita-
 ments and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in anywise appertaining both in law and
 equity. This Indenture Grant is intended as a
 Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four
 Hundred Dollars on the first of July 1860 with \$100.
 endorsed August the 24th 1860 and also the sum
 of Seventy-five Dollars on September 10th 1860 both
 bearing date March 7th 1860 with interest at 20 per
 cent per annum after maturity until paid
 according to the condition of 2 certain Notes this
 day executed and delivered by the said Caleb S. Pratt
 to the said party of the second part; and this
 conveyance shall be void if such payment be made
 as herein specified. But if default be made in
 payment or any part thereof, as above provided
 then it shall be lawful for the said party of the
 second part, his executors administrators and
 assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises
 hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner
 prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys
 arising from such sale, to retain the amount
