

This Indenture made this twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one between Ephraim Kite Jr. Abraham Wilder, James Blood, John S. Brown and E. D. Ladd, Trustees of the first Unitarian Society of Lawrence Kansas, for and in behalf of said society, of the first part and Thomas Gaffield of Boston, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts of the second part Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in city of Lawrence, Kansas, and described as follows: Lot number one hundred twenty nine (129) on Ohio Street, together with the church standing thereon together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining both in law and equity. This Grant is intended as Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand Dollars, according to the conditions of a certain promissory note executed and delivered by E. D. Ladd, Abraham Wilder, C. W. Babcock and James Blood for use and benefit of said society, on the 6th day of December A.D. 1858, which said note is in the words following to wit: \$1000. For value received we jointly and severally promise to pay Thomas Gaffield or order one thousand dollars and the interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent per annum until paid, due and payable in the following installments to wit: One hundred dollars and the interest on principal on the 1st day of January A.D. 1860, and one hundred dollars and the interest
