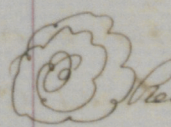

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and Geo. W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and William Hutchinson, party of the second part. Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trusts, and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, in hand paid by said Wm. Hutchinson of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have conveyed, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents do convey, release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of Land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Pearl, October A.D. 1854 as follows: To wit: Share number seventy one (71) containing lots as follows: Pinkney Street two (2) - Park twenty two (22) - Indiana Street one hundred eighty nine (189) - Ohio Street one hundred ninety seven (197) - New York Street fifty
