Motion carried.

Mr. Charles Stough, Attorney, appeared before the Board to discuss his legal fees in connection with the various sewer districts within the County. Mr. Stough advised to prepare itemized vouchers of expenses and submit them to the Board.

Approved monthly bills for payment.

John Ciyatt, Zoning Administrator, appeared before the Board to discuss the advisability or necessity of a review of the Douglas County Zoning Regulations, pertaining to acceptable uses of land in areas where mining or quarrying of rock is presently being conducted. It was moved by Mr. Glass, that the Zoning Administrator be advised that there appears to be no necessity of any review or change at this time and the present regulations should remain as written. Seconded by Mr. Booth, motion carried.
