AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authorized the installation of additional radio equipment for Douglas County;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has requested permission of the University of Kansas to install a DB-22E antenna to the existing pipe atop the Marvin Hall Tower;

AND WHEREAS, the University of Kansas has granted permission for such installation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a DB-22E antenna be installed to the existing pipe atop the Marvin Hall Tower at the University of Kansas under the conditions that:

(1) In the event the needs of the University increase to the point that removal of said antenna is warranted, the County will remove the antenna within ninety days following a written request directed to the Board of County Commissioners for such removal.

(2) No County equipment is to be placed in the existing micro-wave cabin at the base of the tower, but the Board of County Commissioners and the University of Kansas will negotiate for erecting a separate shelter sufficient to house and protect the County base station equipment.

(3) The University assumes no liability for any damage to others which might result from the installation or existence of
