The Board approved a request for a secondary construction project on FAS #209 Santa Fe Flashing Signal within the City limits of Eudora, Kansas. Project to be for flashing signal for approved for crossing protection on the main line of the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad. Estimated cost if \$25,000.

> Mr. E. V. Skidmore, architect, appeared before the Board to discuss the proposed air conditioning of Valleyview Nursing Home. He will submit a proposal for his service and he anticipates that the necessary information could be developed on or before August 12, 1969.

The Board received the quarterly operating statement from Valleyview Nursing Home for the quarter ending March 31, 1969.

The Board received a note commending the Board for their action on the establishment of a food stamp program within Douglas County.

The Board received a letter from Mr. Ivan F. Shull, Chief of General Engineering and Sanitation Division, Kansas State Board of Health enclosing a copy of the Board of Health regulations establishing the boundaries of Clinton Reservoir Sanitation Zone and a drawing showing the same zone.

The Board received an ammended proposal from the engineering firm of Schlup, Becker, and Brennan covering the proposal to furnish the plans and specifications for a proposed Kansas River Bridge at Lawrence, Kansas. No action taken.

The Board received a letter from Mr. Bernard H. Voges, Assistant Superintendent of Lawrence Unified School District #497 pertaining to Bridge inspection through the County on routes used by School busses.

The Board received a letter from Mr. Clayton Stone pertaining to the establishment of a road in Willow Springs Township. Copy of letter was forwarded to the County marded to the County Engine with a request that he make arrangements to have the requested south line of the section staked and flagged as requested by Mr. Stone.
