deputy sheriff

Mr. Virgil Reeves, Mayor of Baldwin, and Mr. Otto Selzer, President of Council, and Sheriff Rex Johnson appeared before the Board to discuss the present arrangement of the City of Baldwin participating in the employment of a deputy sheriff who lives within the City of Baldwin. After considerable discussion, it was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that in compliance with the agreement dated April 27, 1966 at the request of the City of Baldwin, notice be given that the working agreement terminate as of September 1, 1969. As of September 1, the deputy sheriff who has been being paid jointly by the City of Baldwin and Douglas County will become a full time employee of the County. Motion carried unanimously.
