The Board discussed the allocation of deposits of County funds by the County Treasurer for the year 1970. After consideration and discussion, it was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the following policy be adopted for the deposit of County Funds by the County Treasurer's office for the year 1970. The allocation between the banks of Douglas County shall be on a percentage determined from the following formula.

The percentage shall be determined by establishing a percentage of the total assets held by each respective bank as of June 30, 1968, in proportion to the total assets held by all Douglas County banks as of June 30, 1969. Totthis figure, will be added a percentage fact r of 16 2/3%; this percentage giving effect to the number of banks presently located in D uglas County. The combined percentages shall then be divided by two to establish the final applicable percentage of deposit allocation.

This final percentage shall be used by the County Treasurer effective January 1, 1970 and will remain in effect during the calendar year 1970 and until further notice. All deposits to the six Douglas County Banks effective January 1, 1970 shall be active account for the County Treasurer.
