*Road petition of Ed Grosdidier*

Mr. Ed Grosdidier appeared before the Board with road petition for a proposed road to be opened in Section 18, Township 14, Range 19, of Douglas County; proposed road to be of 40 foot width. After discussion, it was decided by Mr. Grosdidier to contact the adjacent property owners and determine the advisability of construction of this road as a private roadway before further action should be taken by the Board of County Commissioners. If Mr. Grosdidier is unable to secure from the adjacent property owners the necessary land to construct the road, proceedings under the road petition as set forth in KSA 68-117 will be started by the Board of County Commissioners.

*tax appeal summons*

The Board received Summons' in Case #25691; plaintiff being Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternal Association, A Corporation, and Case #25693; plaintiff being Alpha Kappa Lambda Building Association, A Corporation. Both Summons' deal with the plaintiffs appeal of their personal property tax. A copy of each Summons' was referred to the County Attorney.
