Motion was seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

purchase posts It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the Board accept the bid of Woods Lumber to the County Engineer's Office for the purchase of 150 4" x 4" x 12' creosote posts and 150 4" x 4" x 14' posts at the price of 23.4¢ per board foot, delivered to the County Shop. Motion carried unanimously.

75.00 for curtains for 4-H Fairgrounds It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the Board allow the Oak Ridge HUD \$75.00 of County funds with which to purchase material for curtains for buildings #1 and #2 at the Fairgrounds.

Wakarusa Watershed Dist. Discussion A discussion was held concerning the Wakarusa Watershed Project adjacent to Louisiana Street. The representative from Baker University, Mr. Carriker, and the Engineer, Mr. Snyder, were to develop easement requirements for the construction of the Bridge, and the County Commissioners advised that they would get a letter of intention to Baker University concerning the proposed vacation of the road and would also contact the superintendent of Haskell Institute concerning the necessary right of way across the government land for the establishment of a new road.
